**Furniture** - Impressive coverage of Shaker furniture. Close-ups of chairs, seed boxes, tools, & baskets. Rooms of furniture.

**Gardens** - Large files of flowers including annuals, biennials, perennials, & ornamental grasses captioned with common & scientific names. Bird & butterfly gardening. Plant combinations, container gardening, seasonal displays. Colorful birds & butterflies on flowers.

**Horticulture** - Extensive coverage of trees, shrubs, berries, prairie plants, wildflowers, annuals, perennials. All captioned with common & scientific names.

**Illinois** - Attractions, farming, scenics, landscapes, festivals, natural areas, state parks, historical sites, reenactments, monuments, capitol, Lincoln sites, wildlife, etc.

**National Parks & Monuments** - Scenics & highlights from: Arches, Blue Ridge Parkway, Canyonlands, Columbia River Gorge, Everglades, Grand Tetons, Great Smoky Mtn, Jefferson Memorial Expansion (Arch in St. Louis), Organ Pipe, Rocky Mtn, Saguaro, Tallgrass Prairie, Theodore Roosevelt, Vietnam Veteran Memorial, Yellowstone, & others.
